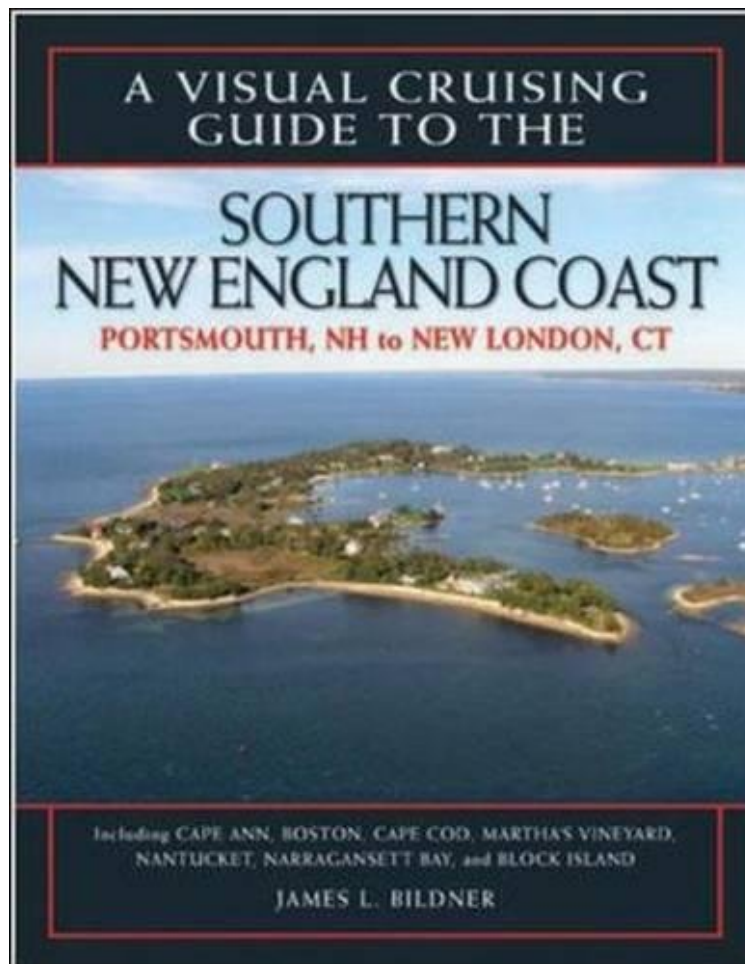

While the guide doesn't contain phone numbers or radio channels for the harbor masters, paired with a smart phone you can get most of the info you need. It would be nice if it contained this info as the most recent popular cruising guide for the area was last published around the late 1990s I believe. The visual guides are useful, and the channel markers are helpfully superimposed on the pictures so

that you can clearly see where they are located in relation to land. It would be nice also if the anchorages were also marked on the photos so one could gauge their position in relation to the visual markers (obviously mooring fields are easily visible; anchorages less so).1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. It is not what I would call a Cruising Guide per se. No phone numbers, no mooring or slip info, no specific marina info. I almost sent this back, but decided to keep it as a companion to my new Maptech Cruising Guide of the New England Coast that I bought afterwards.If you want aerial views for tough approaches, get this. If you want detailed info, get a Maptech Cruising Guide.
