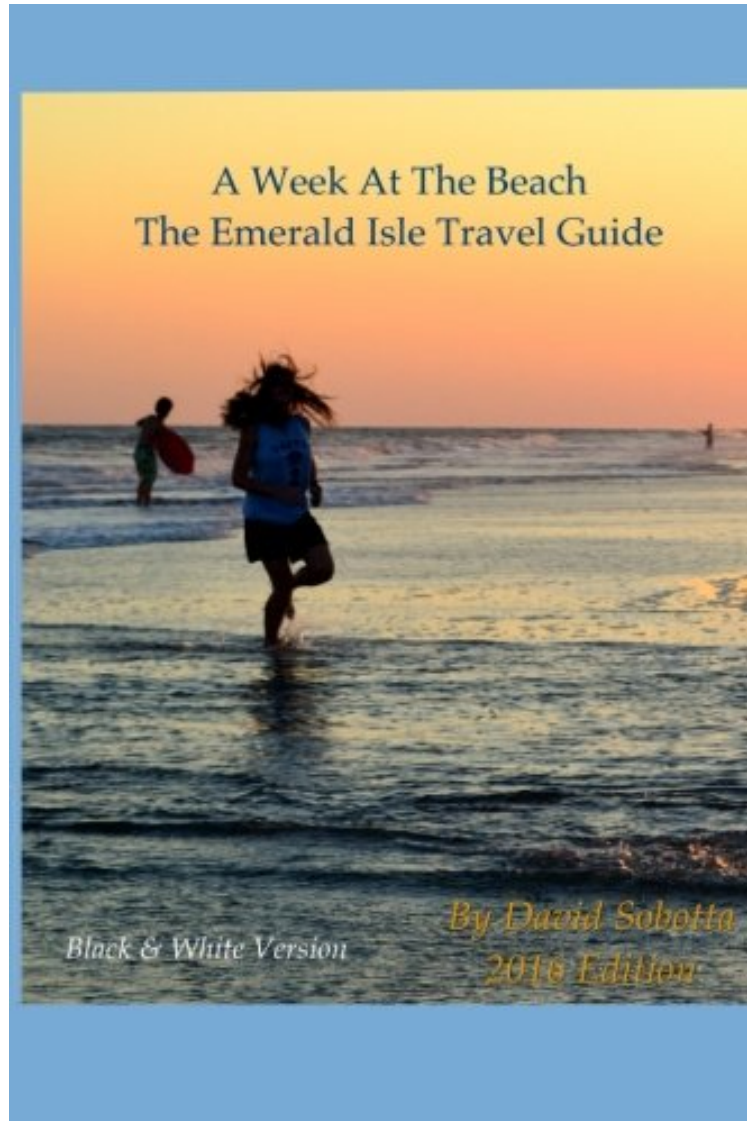

edition. The fact that Sobotta is both an experienced traveler and an experienced resident of the area shows through in all the topics he covers. And the book is jammed with maps and photos. But best of all, Sobotta has taken real advantage of the possibilities inherent in a Kindle book. The central text is short, and it is very easy to find what you are looking for. But it is also stuffed with links on every page that can bring in more detail on any aspect of the guide -- down to the menus of some of the restaurants he likes. Everything you could possibly need is inside -- whether you are reading in your arm chair or have it next to you as you drive to a recommended grocery store.
