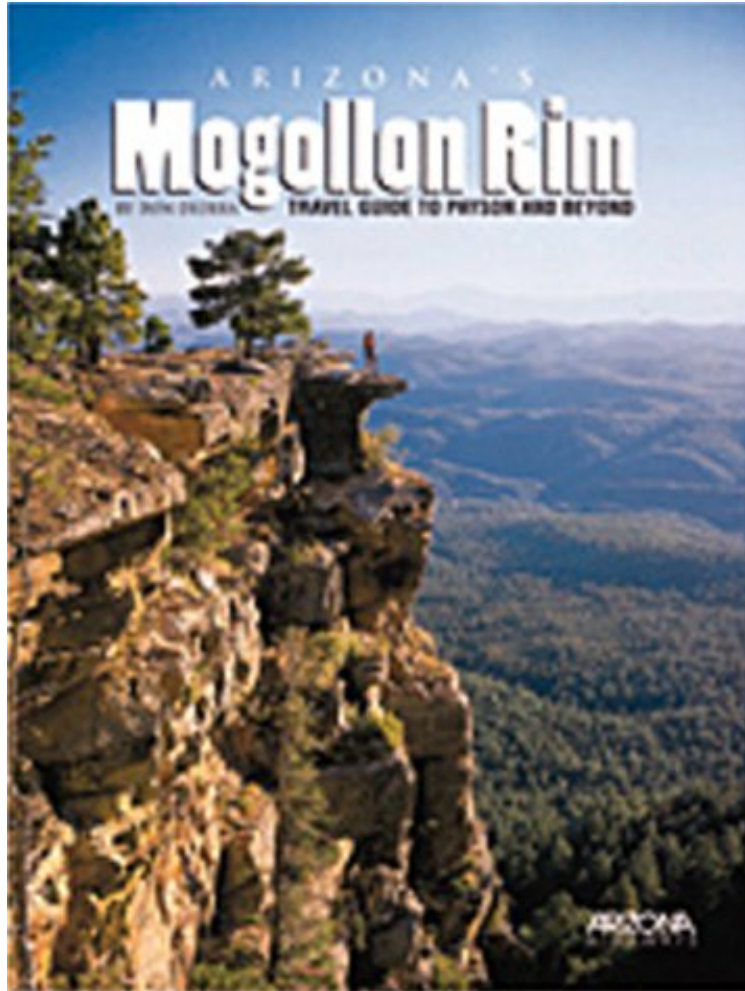

This full-color guidebook shows the region's many picturesque places to go and things to do, with a little historical color thrown in. Introducing readers to a virtual year-round outdoor playground, the guide describes

springtime canoeing in pristine lakes, summer hiking through pine forests and boulder-strewn streams, autumn strolls beneath golden canopies of quaking aspen, and Nordic-style skiing in snow-packed fields. Anglers will find good descriptions of lakes in the area as well as fishing tips. Orientations to the friendly towns of Payson, Pine and Strawberry highlight local attractions and include historical anecdotes that punctuate each town's individuality.
