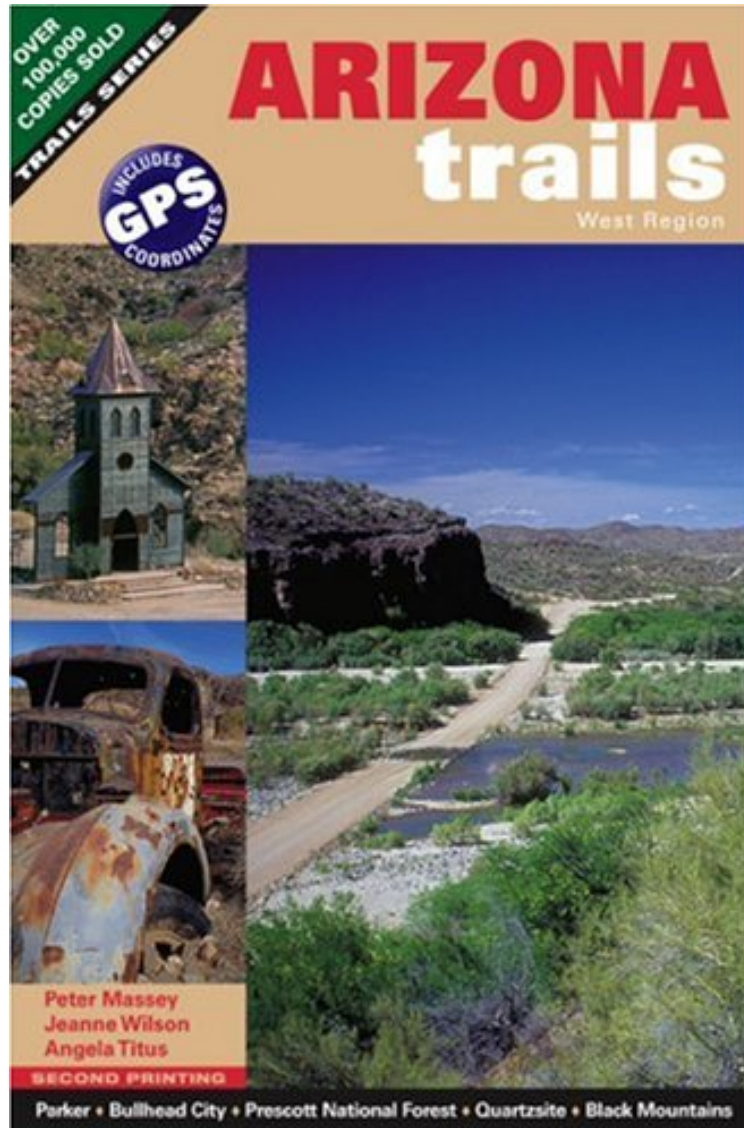

This book published in 2006 is not as refined as the authors book on Nevada Trails published in 2008 but it is still excellent. The maps are very good but they are not topographical. The legend is not as extensive as in the Nevada book but they both have GPS locations. There are many photographs but again not as many as in the Nevada book. This may be because this book is about 75 pages less. I compared this book against many other books on Arizona Trails and it was the best one I could find. I highly recommend it.

This handy 6 x 9 guidebook is a new, full color volume that navigates 485 miles of backcountry trails in western Arizona, near the towns of Bullhead City, Lake Havasu City, Parker, Kingman, Prescott (west), and Quartzsite (north). See ghost towns, old mines and mill workings, old railroads and stage lines along the 33 off-road trails. Directions include GPS coordinates and all trails are rated for difficulty, mileage, driving time, remoteness and more. Descriptions highlight places to camp, hike, mountain bike, fish, and sightsee. Histories recount the days of the Wild West.
