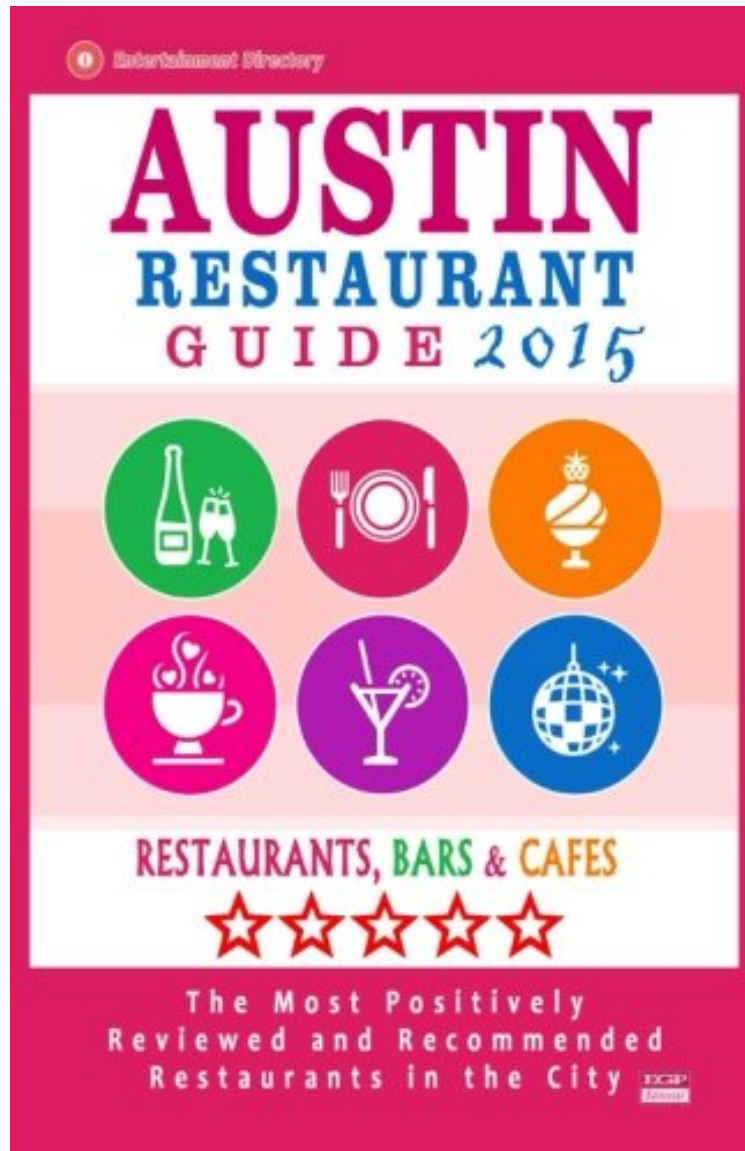

It is a list of 500 restaurants in the Austin area, apparently ranked by online reviews from customers. The restaurants are actually listed 1 through 500, in order of popularity. It gives the address, phone number, type of food, and price range. That's it. If you are looking for a restaurant in a certain part of town, you are out of luck. If you feel like Italian food, and want to search for that type of cuisine, or any other, you are out of luck. If you want to look up the address or phone number of a restaurant you just heard about, better head to the internet. You won't get that here. **BECAUSE THE RESTAURANTS ARE NOT IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER OR BY CUISINE CATEGORY.** They are in order of popularity, that's it. I think this is crazy because any database that is created can be reordered. The silly book is only 42 pages long. It would have been too expensive at \$3, much less \$9-10. Don't wasted your time or money.
