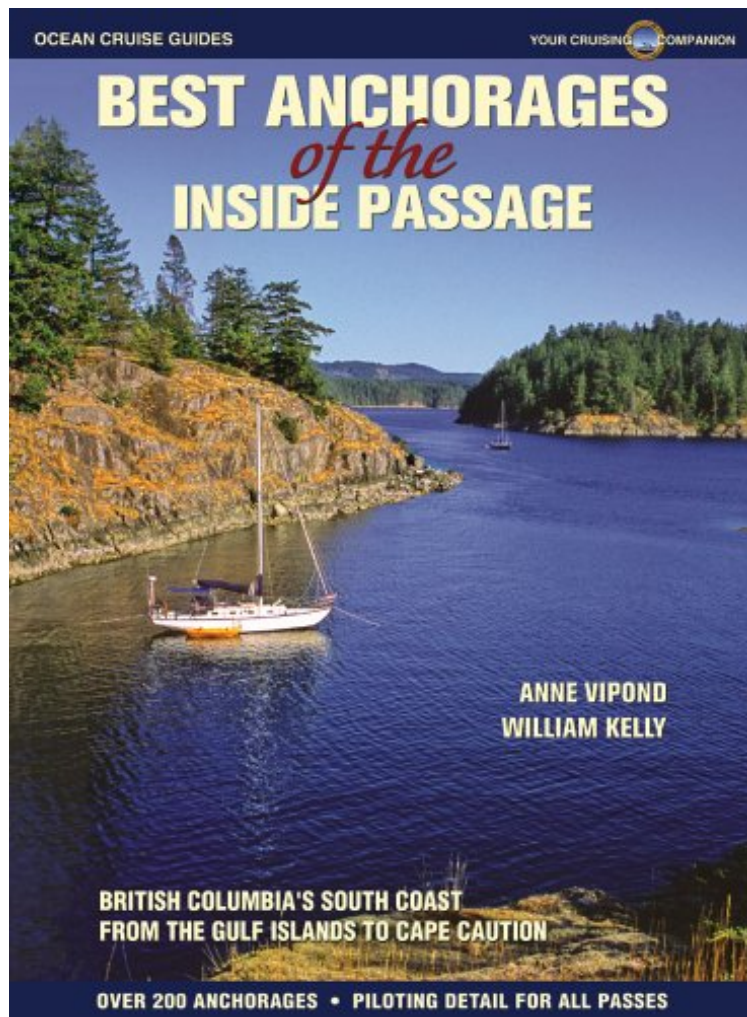

Their boating travels have extended beyond the Inside Passage to Prince William Sound and Kodiak Island. They moor their Spencer 35 on the Fraser River, south of Vancouver, and embark each summer on upcoast cruises with their two young boys. Kelly and Vipond have written extensively for Pacific Yachting magazine. Bill's cruising articles first appeared on its pages in the early 1980s, and Anne's Gunkholes column premiered in 1992, running for 13 years.
