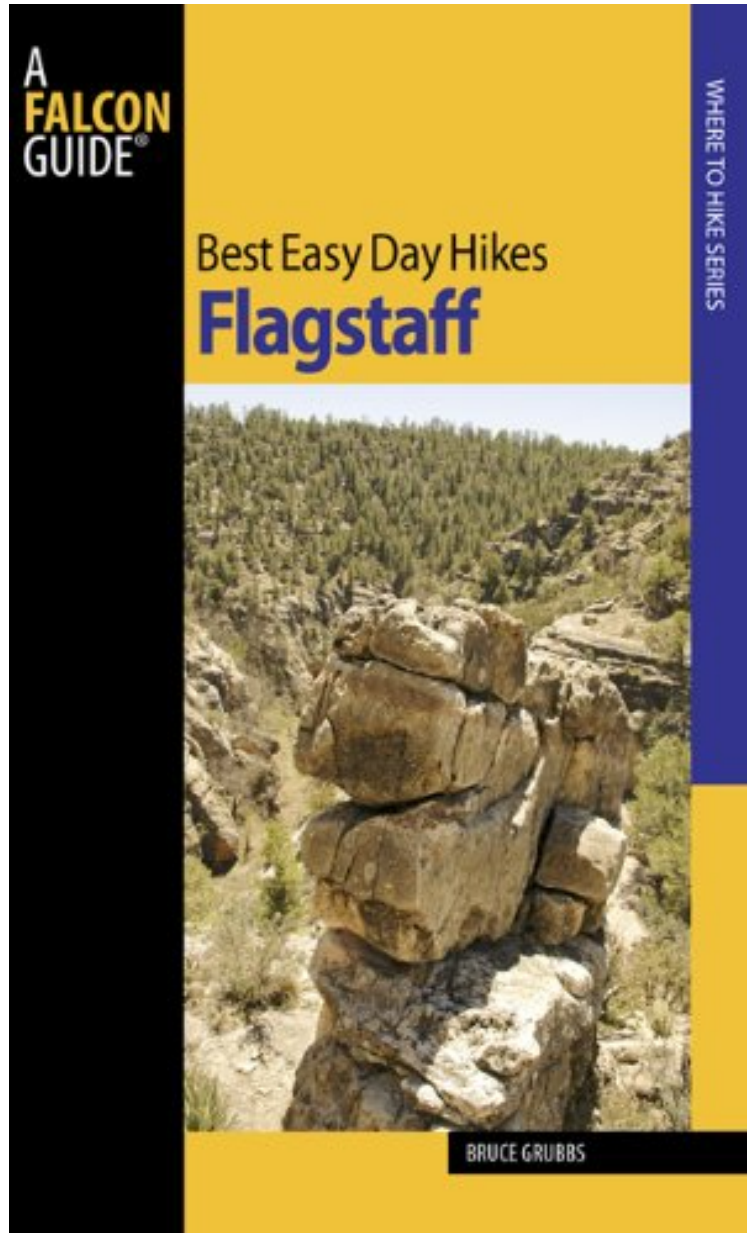

Some volumes in the series provide a nice collection of hikes that are doable by most people while others describe hikes that are easy only for hard core mountaineers. This Best Easy Day Hikes guide for Flagstaff, Arizona has some flaws, but it grades out better than most guides in this series. This guide describes 20 hikes within an hours drive of Flagstaff. Both of the areas national forests (Kaibab and Coconino) are covered, as is Walnut Canyon. There are NO Grand Canyon or Sedona hikes in this guide. The average trail length is only about 3 miles, although there are a couple of fairly flat hikes that are over 10 miles long. The trail descriptions are rather terse, but that is the result of packing 20 hikes into 84 pocket-sized pages. The main problem with this guide is the maps. The maps are typical Falcon maps that show few details and no contour lines. Contour lines are really needed for areas of high relief such as the San Francisco Peaks north of Flagstaff: it is impossible to judge how steep the trail is without them. I have complained about Falcons maps in several reviews, and I have (yet again) docked one of their guides a star for the poor quality maps. In summary, this guide contains some good trail information and hike ideas.
