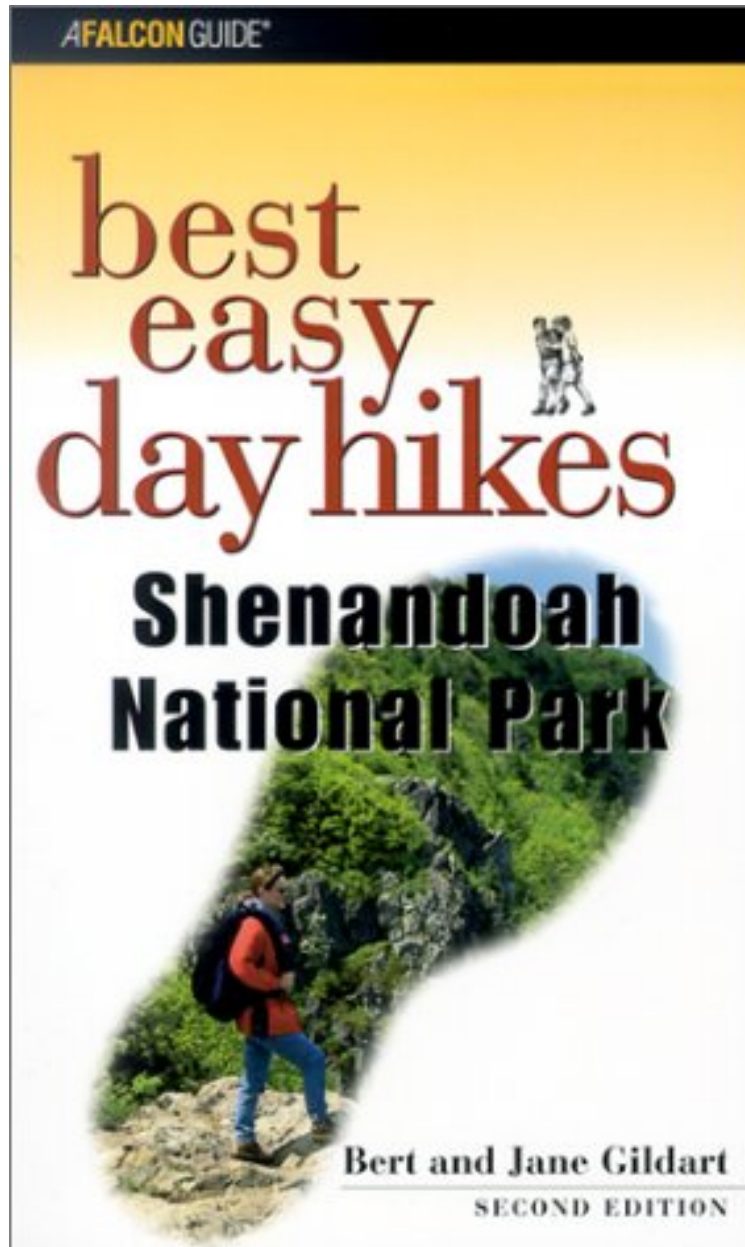


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## Best Easy Day Hikes Shenandoah National Park, 2nd (Best Easy Day Hikes Series)

It is small and light enough (only about 100 pages and the dimension is about 4"x7") to carry in a backpack and not have to feel the weight. It is concise and extremely helpful. The trails are organized by mile post marks and there is a list of all trails in order of difficulty. The description of each hike gives the total mileage of the trail, highlights and landmarks along the trail and a map. Now my goal for the next couple of years is to complete all the trails covered in this book, and I am sure it will be indispensable!
