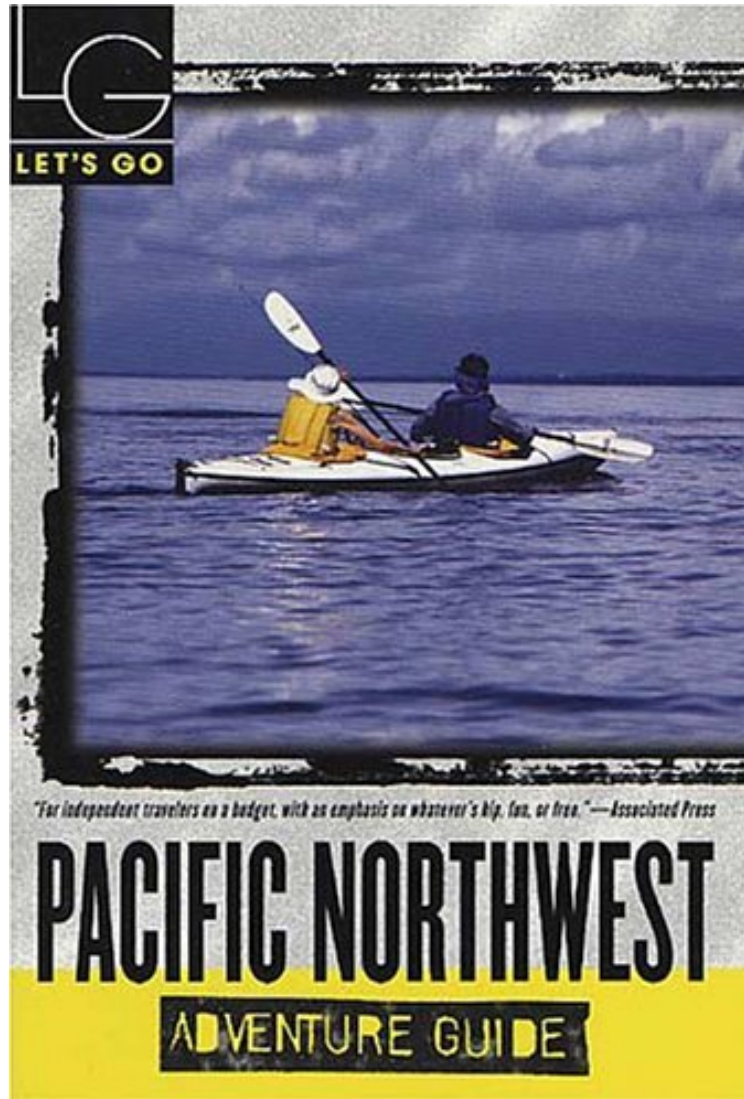

The downside I found was that it isn't very detailed. Because it covers such a wide area it doesn't get into too much detail on any one place. In light of this I was surprised to see it go into information on most cities... because it's an Adventure guide, I was expecting it to be much more focused on outdoor
