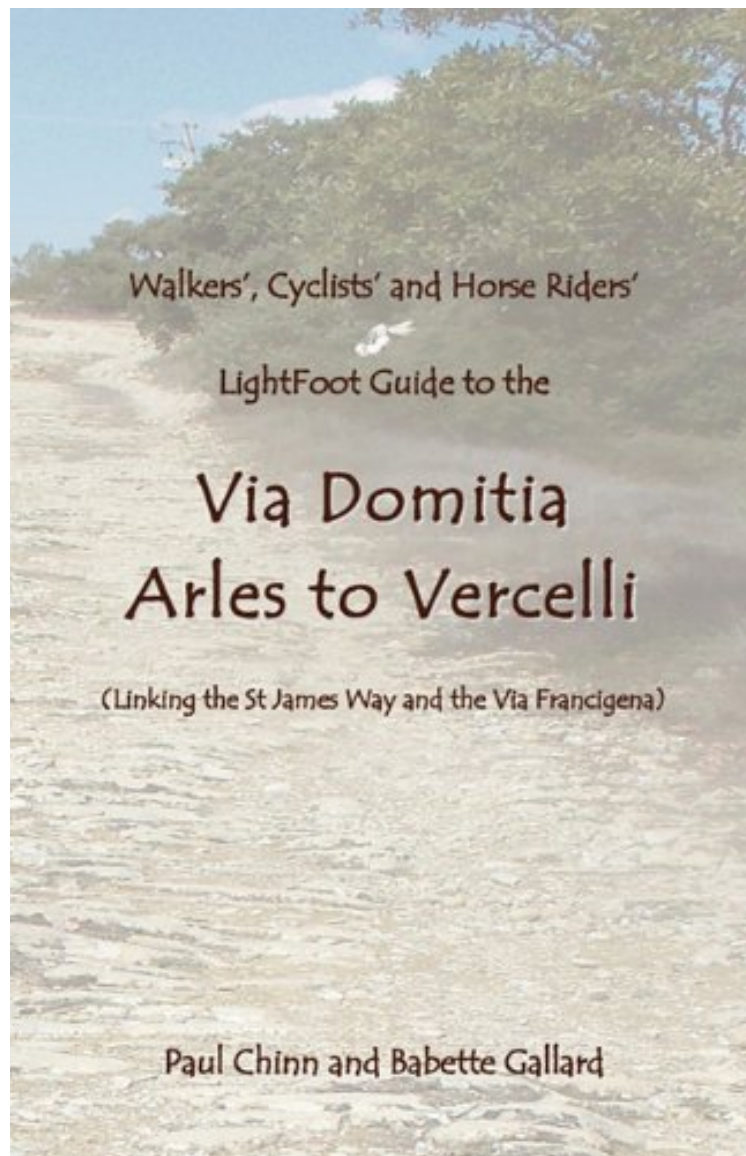

I used this guide to walk from Fontvieille (just after Arles) to the Luberon Park, approximately 5 days worth, and I would have without a doubt been lost many times without it. This is a meticulously written step by step (almost literally) guide book based on Babette's extensive knowledge and experience of the area. It provides direction at every turn where often there was none on the road. It is clear and easy to follow, with a detailed account of distances in kms, landmarks and altitudes per stage, as well as accommodation and food contacts at each recommended stop. I would say it is necessary, and have no hesitation recommending all other Lightfoot publications based on this experience.
