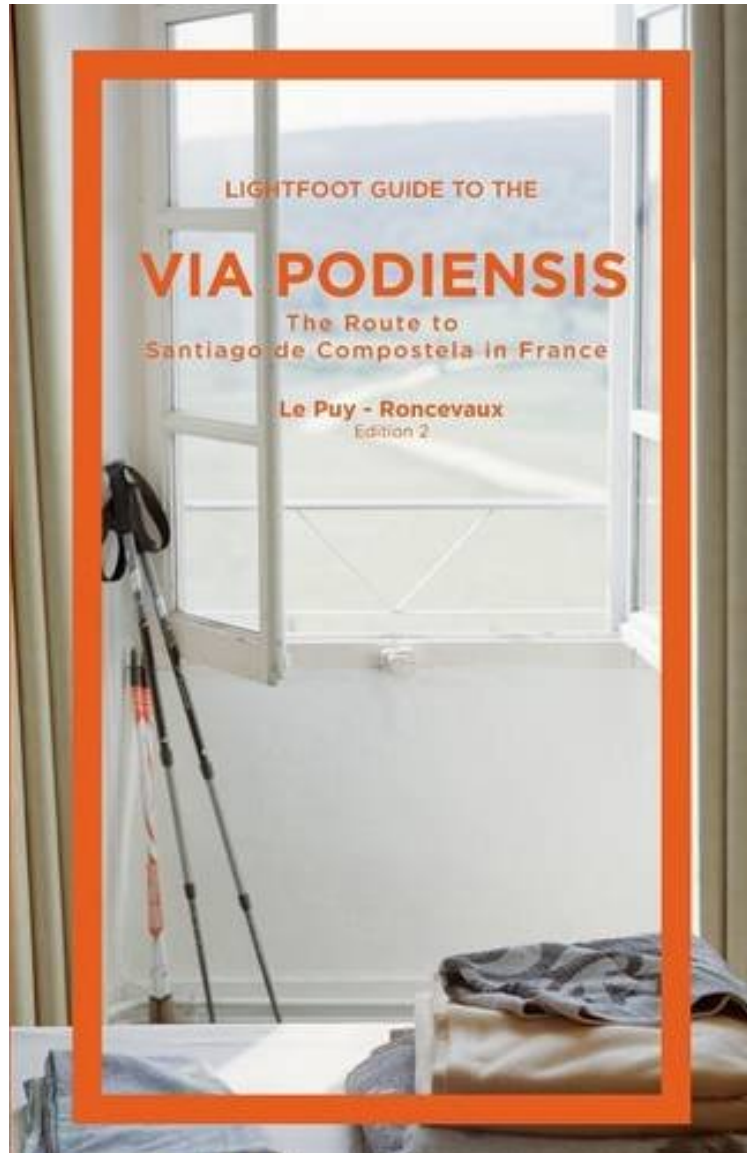

It is a contemporary guide to one of the most popular hiking trails in France: the 774km route from Le Puy-en-Velay to the Pyrenees, the starting point of the Spanish Camino. The Lightfoot guide contains: - detailed descriptions of 34 stages and three major alternative routes; - full-colour topographical maps for each stage plus detailed city maps; - elevation profiles and turn-by-turn walking instructions; - up-to-date information on accommodation; - historical and cultural overviews; and- practical information about preparing your trip and life on the trail.
