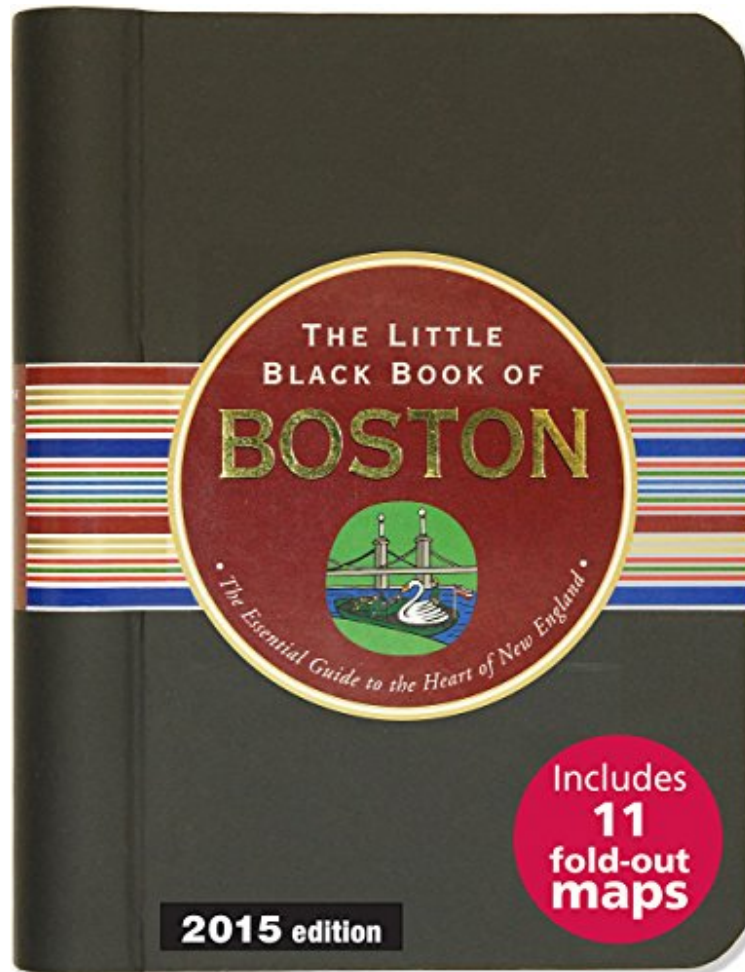

Cambridge, suburbs, and excursions outside Boston are covered, too! Color-coded, numbered entries in the text are keyed to full-color neighborhood maps in each chapter. A city map inside front cover shows you where each neighborhood is located. 11 fold-out maps, including 8 Boston neighborhood maps, a map of attractions in Boston's suburbs, an area "Excursions" map, and a MBTA Boston transportation map. "Top Picks" direct you to not-to-be-missed attractions. Full-color spot illustrations throughout liven the text. "Notes" pages let you record your own discoveries. 4-1/4 inches wide by 5-3/4 inches high (10.8 cm wide by 14.6 cm high). Elastic band attached to back cover keeps your place or keeps book closed. Concealed wire-o hardcover binding; book lies flat for ease of use. "Black Book" travel guide format doesn't look "touristy." Author Maria T. Olia is a freelance travel writer based in Boston.
