The descriptions and information in it were pretty outdated. The whole section about the Hummingbird Highway paints a pretty different picture than what we found when we actually

got there. I was disappointed with what we found. The same goes for the section about San Ignacio. I do not recommend staying in the city but around it. In general, I would not recommend planning your stay in Belize with this book.
