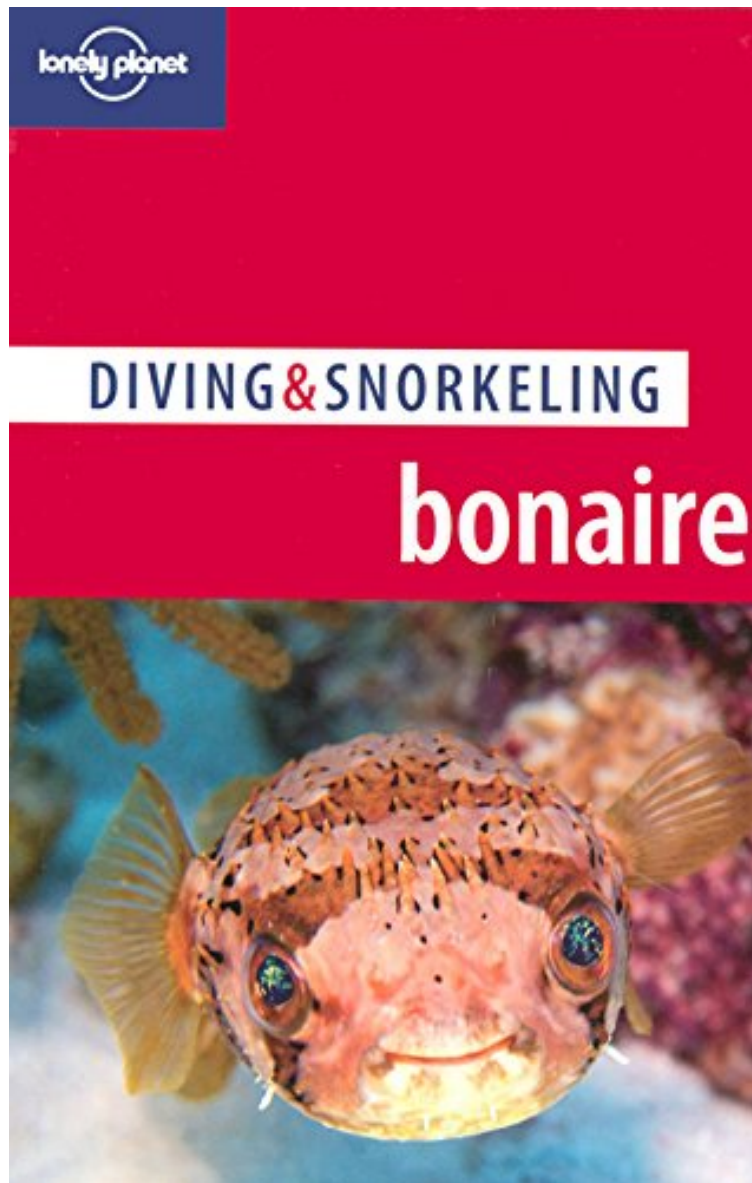

The real benefit to the book is the descriptions of each of the dive locaions. Along with

beautiful pictures, the dive locations are described (including where to park, what the terrain is like at the entry, the coral formations present) and the types of commonly seen marine life. Some of this information is found in tourism pamphlets around the island (see your dive center or resort) but we really enjoyed having this book as our own personally dive tour guide.
