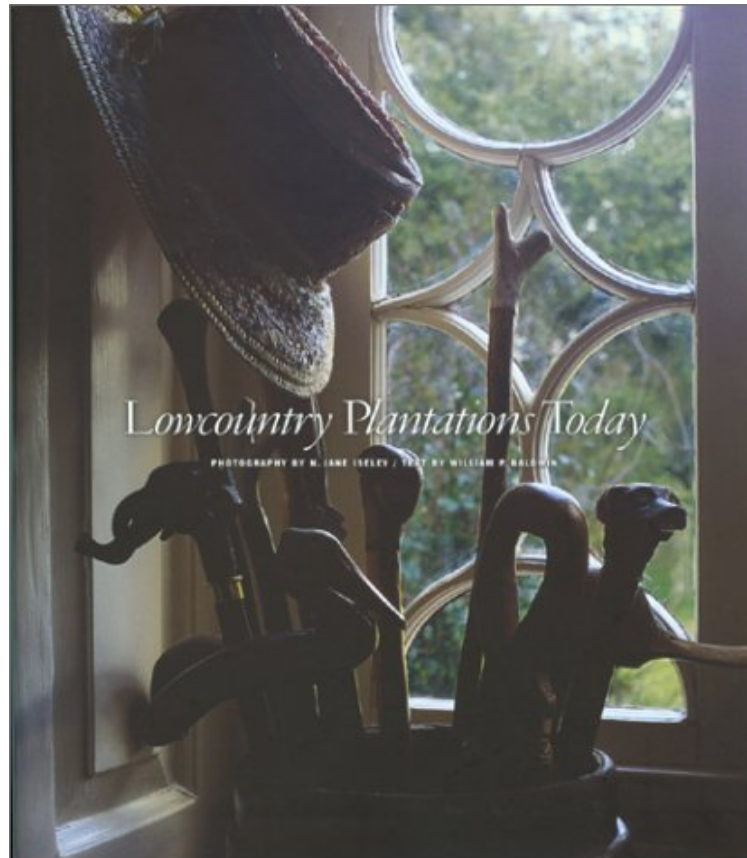

Albee I must say that I agree with another reviewer who mentioned that he was disappointed with this book. I was also disappointed, having expected something much more professional from a \$60 book. This is a book of photography, yes. There are some good shots of gardens and architectural details, but the ubiquitous interior shots and more than a few of the exterior photographs are just plain dull. There's only a half-hearted attempt at visual artistry. The text offers some historical contexts, but falls well short of anything an architectural historian would find either interesting or helpful. Then there's the selection of sites. Some of the most well known sites are here, but a lot of these buildings are really nothing more than big houses, with little architectural, artistic or historical distinction. Many of them were built after the Civil War, and some in the 20th century.
