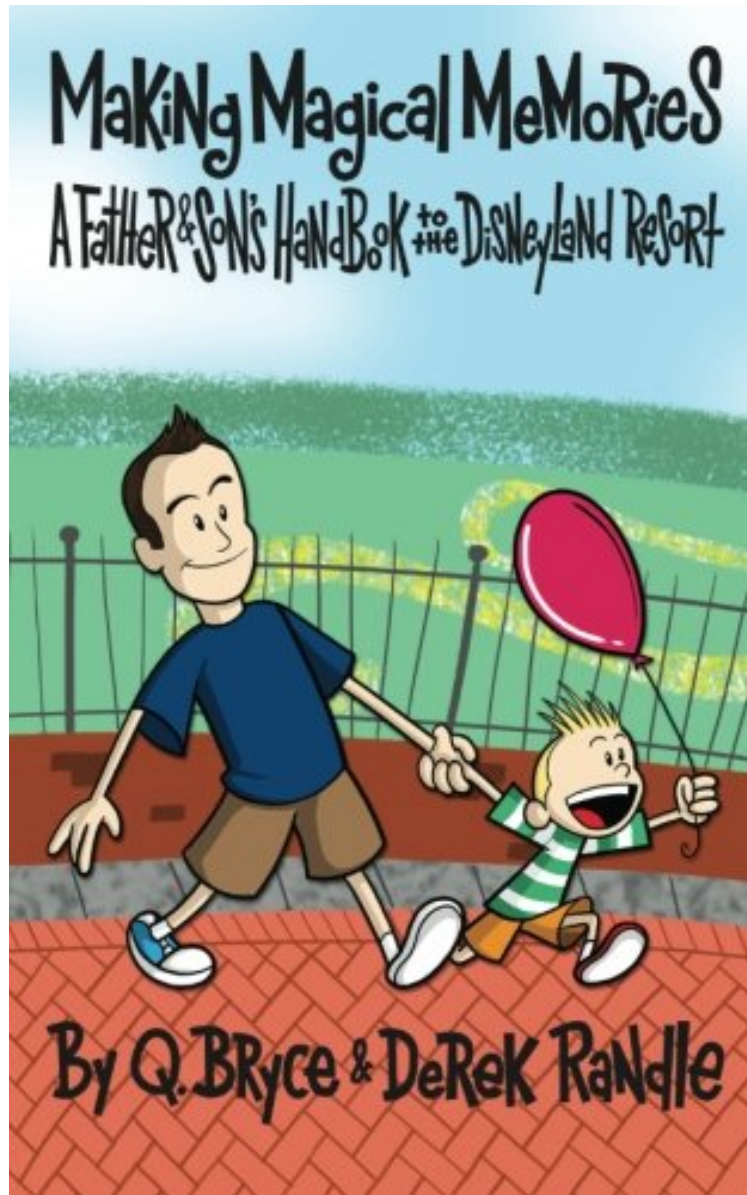

This is a great little book by neophyte author Q. Bryce Randle, aided materially by his son, Derek, and put out by that magical publishing company Theme Park Press by Bob McLain. Derek add a number of very helpful notes and tips, such as a great way to rack up points on Astro Blasters, what rides are scary for kids and why, etc-). The book is simple and fun, each chapter covers a "ideal day' at Disneyland (and DCA) with a Father and his Son- what to do, where to eat, what to see and a few trivia and "look for this" games. (Have you Seen it? A Stormtrooper walking around, a Policeman in uniform, etc). Nearly every ride and attraction, not to mention eatery is covered. The Randle's tell you about each attraction, why you should ride it and tips for riding it, when the line is shortest and other tips. The book also covers places to eat and get snacks. This is one place I disagree with Bryce- he spends a lot of time giving you out of the park eating ideas- but when I am in Disneyland, I don't want to leave! Sure you can save a few bucks eating outside, but that usually means a hour + of prime Disney time wasted! Note also, things come and go so fast in the parks, a few sections are already a little outdated.
