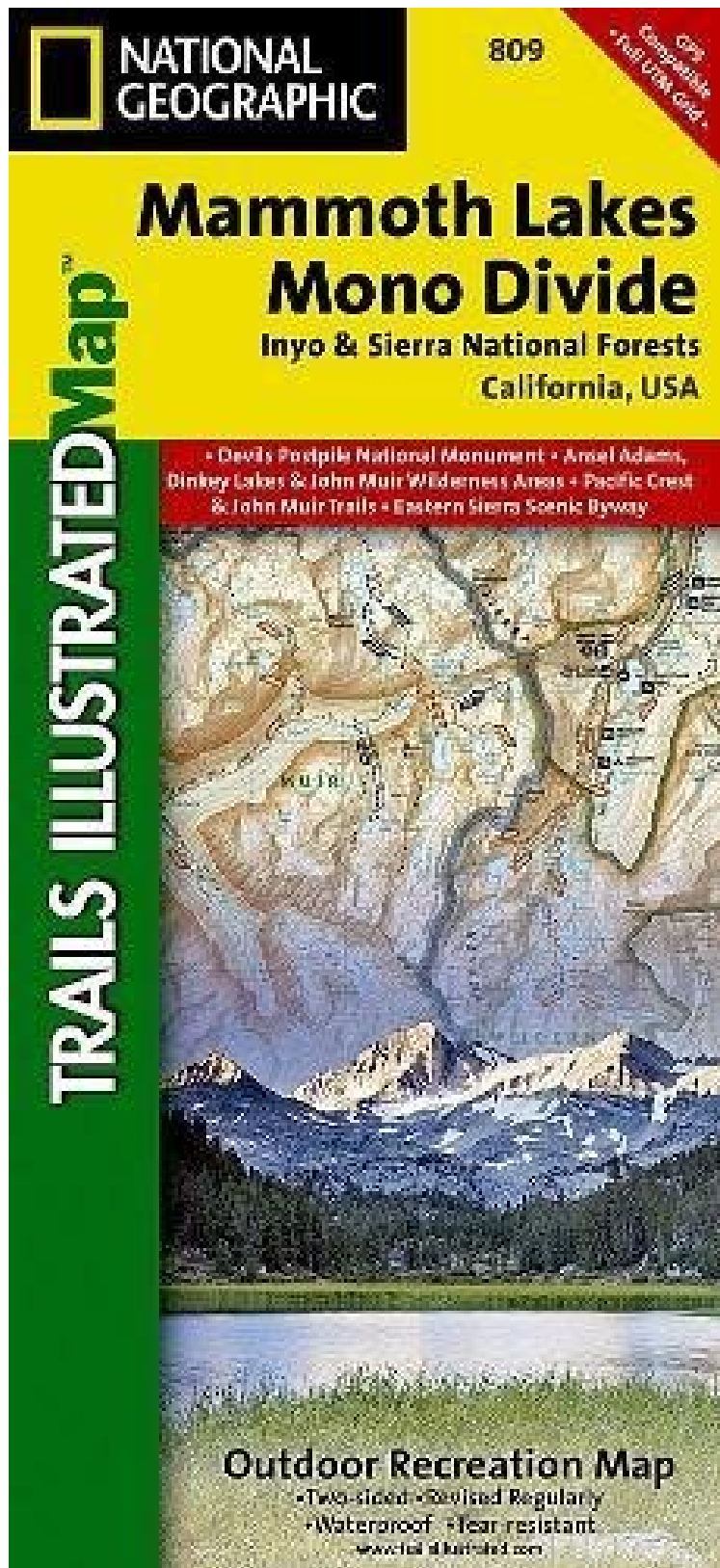

I was very surprised by the quality. When I first opened the package, I was ready to call and complain because the material felt just like normal paper. I re-read the description on the store page -- yep, water-proof, tear resistant, etc. I took that as a challenge and put the seemingly normal paper map under the faucet and blasted it -- only to watch the water glide right off. So I grabbed the corner of the map and tried to rip it, and it stretched a little after applying pressure. Whoa. I don't know what these maps are made of, but I'm impressed. The color is great too, I'm sure the maps themselves are accurate because they are highly rated in that regard when I checked elsewhere. I didn't expect the quality of the actual material.
