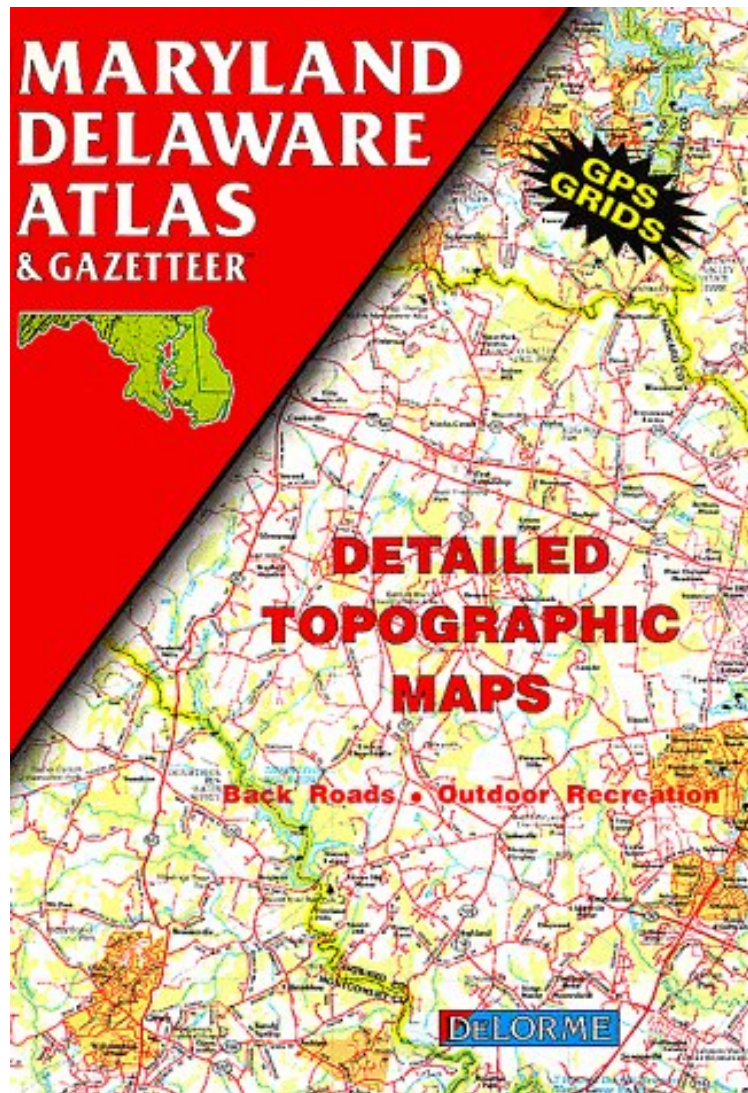

Because I like the countryside far

more than the city, I spent my weekends exploring various parts of Maryland. As I look back, I wish I'd had the Delorme gazetteer back then. I was pretty adventurous in trying the backroads, but from time to time I'd get lost. After grad school I moved to Nebraska, where I still live. However, a few years after leaving Baltimore I married a girl from southeastern Pennsylvania, right across the border from Maryland.
