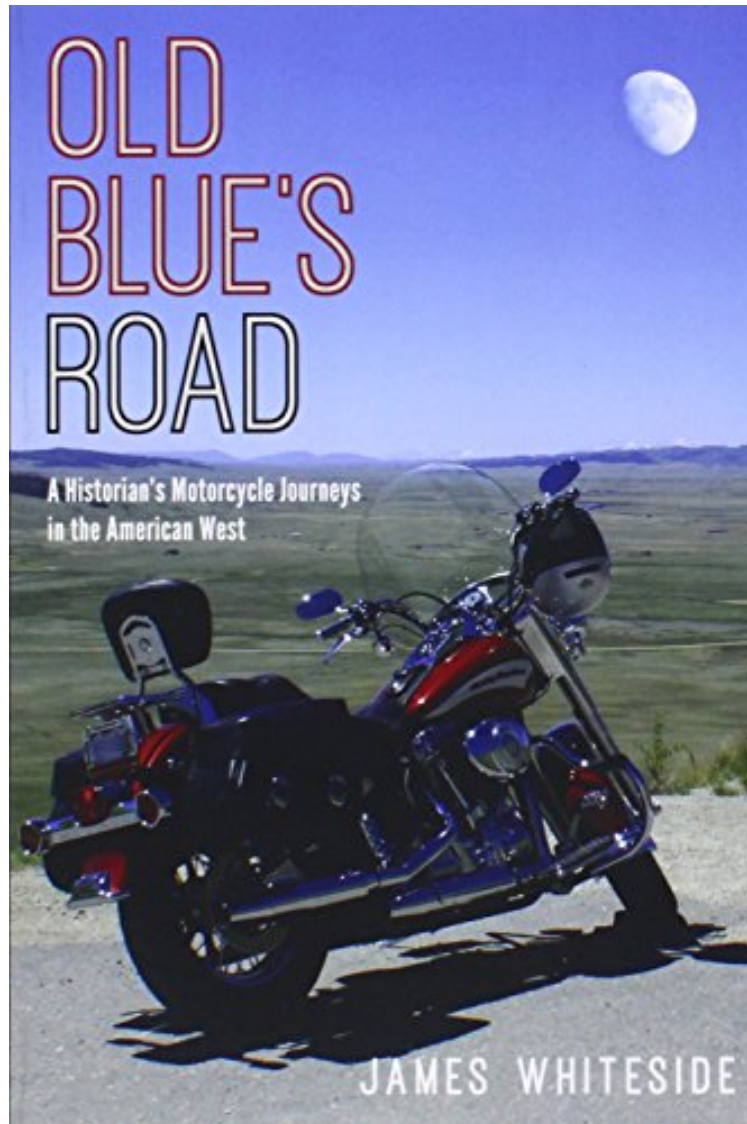

In 2005, Whiteside bought a Harley Davidson Heritage Softail, christened it Old Blue, and set off on a series of far-reaching motorcycle adventures. Over six years he traveled more than 15,000 miles. Part travelogue and part historical tour, this book takes the reader along for the ride. Whitesides travels to the Pacific Northwest, Yellowstone, Dodge City, Santa Fe, Wounded Knee, and many other locales prompt consideration of myriad topics: the ongoing struggle between Indian and mainstream American culture, the meaning of community, the sustainability of the West's hydraulic society, the creation of the national parks system, the Mormon experience in Utah, the internment of Japanese Americans during World War II, and more. Delightfully funny and insightful, *Old Blues Road* links the colorful history and vibrant present from Whitesides unique vantage point, recognizing and reflecting on the processes of change that made the West what it is today.
