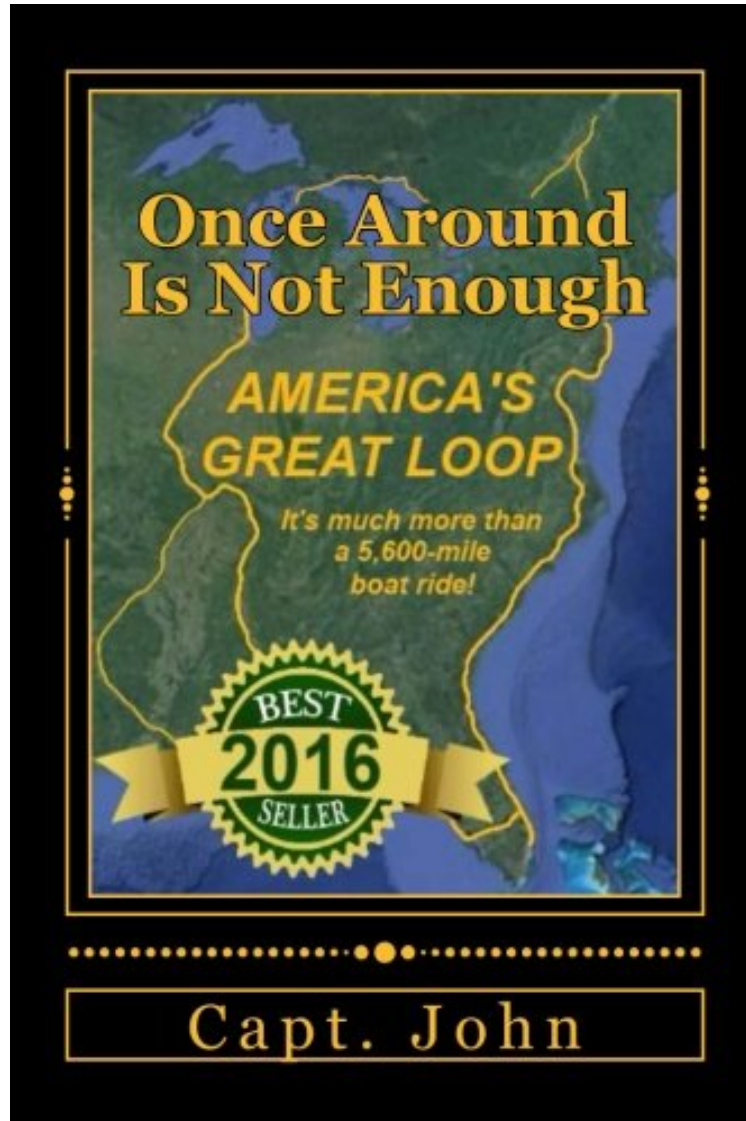

The content was ok, but having also completed the Loop, I disagreed with a lot of it. For example, speed. Granted you don't want to go fast through much of it, and there are many areas where you have to go slowly,

but I want to go faster than bicycle speed when crossing Abermarle Sound or Lake Michigan. And I don't think the basic loop goes through 22 states without some significant side trips (Washington D.C. is definitely a long side trip (but worthwhile) [I'm from D.C. so I know how long a trip it is from the Chesapeake Bay], as are any of the states in New England); even the route on the AGLCA bugee does not touch those areas. However, I agree that 'Once Around is not Enough;' we are currently looping for the second time, and doing different side trips from last year and enjoying ourselves immensely.
