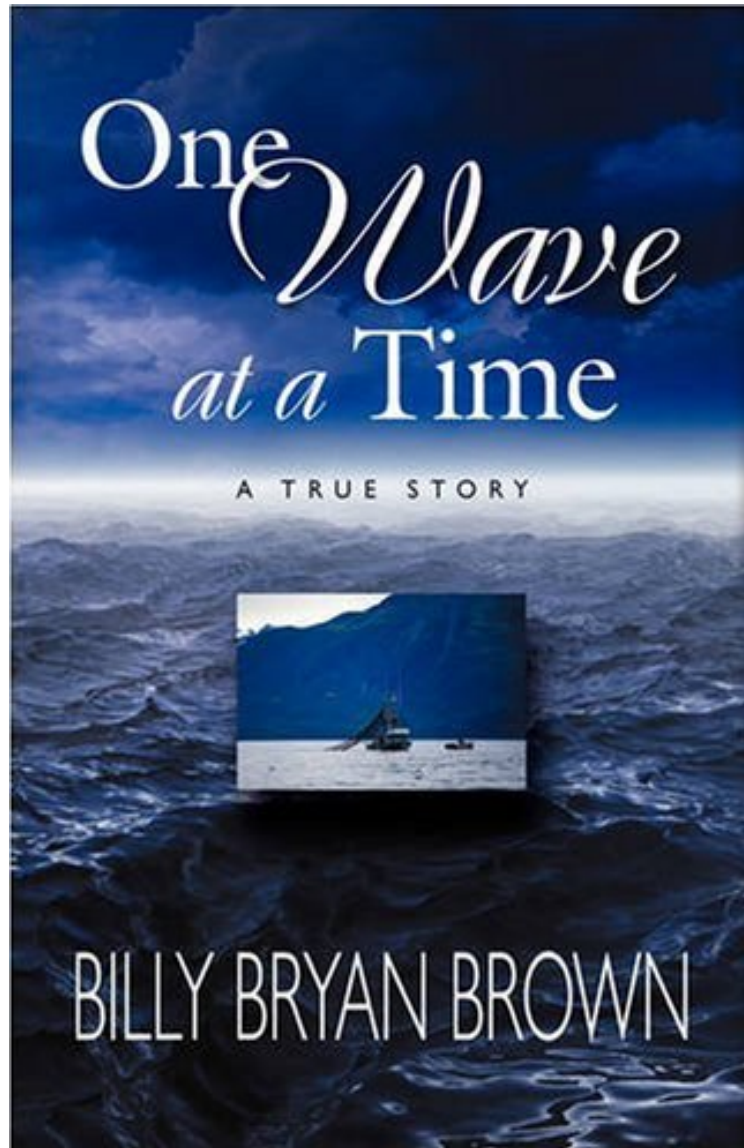

I've always been an avid reader of biographies and this one doesn't disappoint. Billy introduces the story with the heartbreaking loss of his entire family when he was a teen. He continues to narrate his life until the time when he

and his family embark on a journey to the lower forty-eight states to find a publisher for Billy's books (children's books that he had written and his sons had illustrated). One always has to be cautious when reading autobiographies - an individual's perception of an event doesn't necessarily make it truth. While the veracity of some of Billy's account may come into question, I'm not here to debate that. I'm just reviewing the merits of reading the book itself. Besides, of all the extraordinary happenings Billy writes about - from storms, losing a home to fire, and the births of seven children - those facts are not really the point of this book. The real story is that of a man's loss, how he copes with that loss, who he is at the core, and how he never wavers when it comes to the important things in life: love of family and independence of body and spirit. Billy's search takes him hither and yon, but he ultimately finds that elusive thing, or perhaps it finds him. And he realizes that it had been with him since the moment he met his wife. My only complaint about the book is that Billy needed an editor. There are several grammatical errors, but I doubt that those will bother most readers.
