After reviewing all four, I left this one at home. Although Becky Youman's book is easier on the eyes, the Rough Guide's Southwest travel guide provides more usable content on Arizona. Youman's book is 231 pages. However, after page 150 the guide largely focuses on eating, sleeping and

shopping options. Plus, instead of just referring the reader to what was already written previously, amidst the first 150 pages a lot of content is repeated in sections highlighting what to do for a day, weekend or two week trip. So, in reality, you're not getting 231 pages of fresh content. Overall, this book may fit the styles of certain visitors - particularly those who enjoy spending their vacations inside shopping rather than outside.
