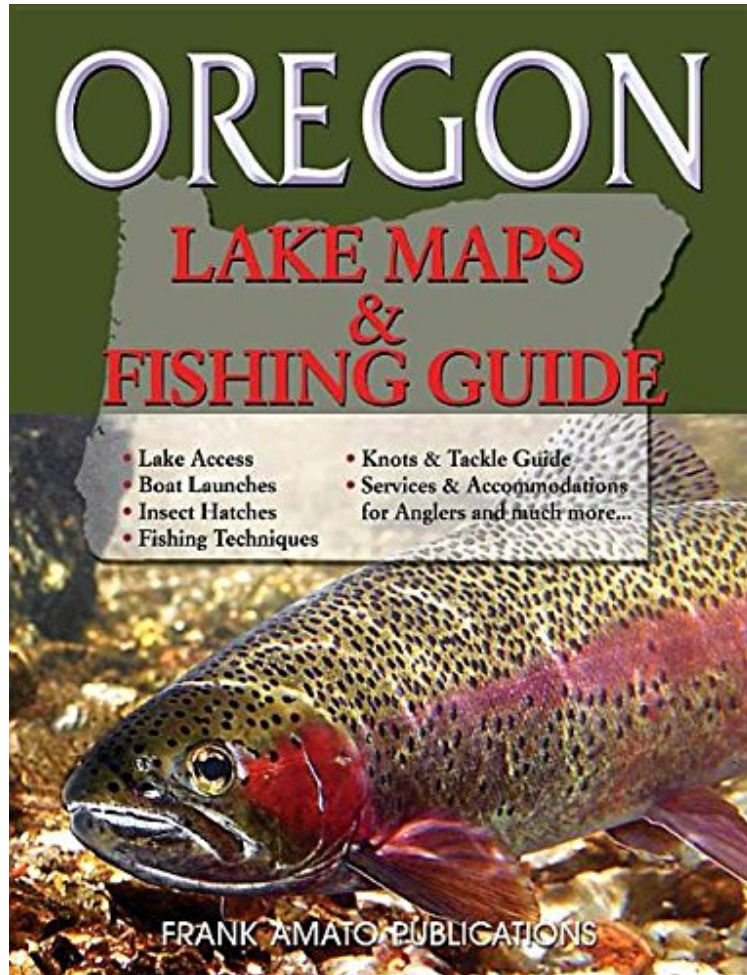

The maps show where the different species of fish like to hang out, but it's not incredibly detailed in that regard. These are definitely not topo-maps - more of an outline with major features like roads, boat launches, deep spots, tributaries, islands, etc. Covers a lot of the popular central Oregon lakes (10 of the 40 lakes are in central Oregon).
