I found, however, that this guide didn't include a lot of flowers I encountered in Missouri. This guide is much better at Missouri. I also have a copy of Missouri Wildflowers, by Edgar Denison, and find that between the two I can look up

about anything that I can find in MO. I will say that between the two Missouri guides this one has much better pictures. Missouri Wildflowers contains a lot of older pictures that have poor resolution. This can be a problem when flowers are clustered, or small, or the plant has small leaves.
